The "CIP Network Statistics" (CIP=Computer Investment Program) is a facility at the Institute of Statistics of Faculty 16 of LMU Munich. It is available to the institute for teaching and training purposes.

- 4. It is forbidden to delete or copy installed software.
- 5. Eating and drinking alcohol are prohibited in the CIP rooms.

Login

Use your LRZ identification to log in to the computers in the CIP pool. How to find out your own LRZ identification:

- 1) Go to https://www.portal.uni-muenchen.de, and log in with your LMU account.
- 2) Click on User Account at the top right.

There, you will see, among other things, your LRZ identifier.

Printing

Users receive a personal printing account. Each user receives a certain quota of free prints. A management program ensures the proper billing of printed pages.

After your application to cip-pool, you will receive a serial number from us by email, with which you can activate your account for printing, by doing the following steps.

- 1) Open print.mwn.de/user in the top bar of the browser. This site is only accessible from the Munich Scientific Network (MWN). That means, directly at a computer in the CIP pool, or in eduroam or using vpn.
- 2) Log in to the site with LRZ identification.
- 3) In the field for Card number, please insert the print code, and confirm by clicking on 'Redeem Card'.

If the available printing quota is used up, it will not be possible to print anymore. You can then request new pages by sending an email to cip-pool@stat.uni-muenchen.de.
